We are very thankful for the 3 month furlough the Lord allowed us to have and for the time reconnecting with some of our supporting churches as well as visiting some new ones. God was very good to us during our furlough and allowed us to raise additional funds for our building project. We also praise the Lord as we were able to partner with a few new churches with prayer and financial support and even a few others raised our support which will go a long way in helping us with our living expenses.

As thankful as we are for our furlough, we are very excited to be back home here in Spain! We hit the ground running from the day we arrived reconnecting with our people and getting them excited about the future of our church.

First, we began planning our Christmas service and passing out special tracts we had made with a Christmas message. A young guy from our Church named Konstantine and myself went to pass them out. Our church is very new in the neighbourhood so we want people to know what we are about and our new location.

We are excited to share that at our Christmas service we had the highest attendance we have ever had at our church! It was so encouraging! A total of 18 first time visitors heard a very clear presentation of the Gospel!

When I got home that evening, a young college student, Albert, who had been coming to our church, sent me a text message saying he wanted to give his life to Christ! I met him the next day and he placed his faith and trust in Jesus Christ and now we are doing a discipleship together. It was an amazing evening and all we can do is praise God.

As we reflect on last year and looking to the beginning of this one, we are looking forward to what the Lord will do this year with Más Vida Baptist Church. We have many plans and outreach ideas, we hope that the Lord uses them to reach our neighbourhood and community with the Gospel.

Building project update:

We have ordered our new windows/door and the counter top for the kitchen. As I write this letter we are waiting for both to be installed but since holidays here last until the 6th of January, we will probably have to wait a little bit longer but we praise God for allowing us to reach this point in our building project.
