On February 15, our Covid tests came back negative (thanks for your prayers), so we made our way to O'Hare on the 16th. United messed up our reservetions because of the extra baggage. We took 100 lbs. of "The Bridge" tracts for the five Hungarian churches, so it took us an hour and a half of negotiations just to check in. After that, our flights were easy and customs in Munich and Budapest were smooth.

This is our seventh replacement in Hungary, so it feels like coming home. The language is coming back, and the tastes, smells, smiles and cultural idiosyncrasies are so familiar. We hit the ground running with services, counseling, visitation,
