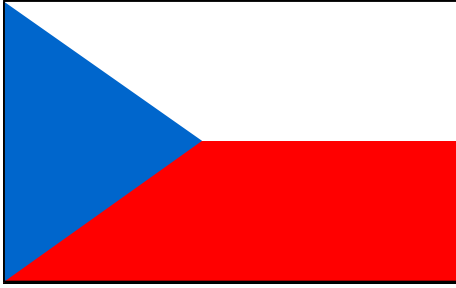

## Group Impact

What a week! I feel like I just spent a week in revival meetings. Yesterday we said goodbye to Pastor Wagenschutz, Asst Pastor Butler, and Christian school teacher, Rachel Wark; along with seven students from their school. The group was made up of juniors and seniors. The students had to earn the money to pay their own way. I don't think I have ever met a more godly group of young people. With their assistance we distributed more than 10,000 John/Romans, gospel tracts, and booklets. The days were filled with teaching morning and evening, distributions ranging from letter boxing to street evangelism, and a great time of fellowship. It isn't possible to express our gratefulness to the Lord for bringing them to us at this time. There is always a great deal of work that goes into hosting a group, but the blessings far outweigh the work involved. I believe the Lord met with us on Sunday. Pastor Wagenschutz brought a great message challenging the saved to serve as well as calling sinners to the Savior. We had one first time visitor in the service, as well as other lost people. The message was well received and we are praying for fruit to abound. Several of the attendees had questions and virtually all of them are glad to have been there. James and David had a fantastic time learning from the elder teens along with playing ping pong and other games. This morning when we got up they both said, "I can't believe they are already gone." In spite of the language barrier, the young people had several opportunities to speak with people on the street. It was our goal to challenge the young people to have an even greater heart for missions and serve the Lord with a fervent heart and spirit. It is our prayer that the Lord will use each of them in a great way.

## Visitors and Contacts

I mentioned that we had one first time visitor. Peter lives here in Modrice and has attended our English outreach classes in the past. The Lord allowed us to minister to his pregnant wife while he was away. He is a soldier in the Czech army and was stationed for six months in Kosovo. After his return they have visited with us a few times and last week he came to church. They have a Catholic background so he had a few questions after hearing Pastor Wagenschutz preach. Pray for this young family, Peter and Jarka (pronounced yarka). As a result of receiving one of our tracts, a woman also contacted me by email asking for more information. She said she was captivated by the tract and wanted to know more. Pray as we follow up on this lead. This lady's name is Martina. We are trusting the Lord to do great things in her life.

## Court Date

I mentioned last month about Janek being taken to court by his son from his previous marriage. Janek tried to negotiate and offered more than he could afford to pay but his offer was rejected. As I said last month, he has always supported his children and has acknowledged his previous failures. He received a summons to appear in court on the 16<sup>th</sup> of May. We are praying for the Lord's will to be done and for the Lord to be exalted in this situation. Janek has faith that the Lord's will shall come to pass. He desires to see his children come to know the Lord Jesus Christ as their personal Savior above all things. We spoke about the fact that every decision we make has consequences. The Lord will forgive all of our sin but very often there are earthly consequences to be faced for decisions we made in the past.
